The Hazardous Material (HAZMAT) Charge is intended to recover the cost of soil remediation at the Gaw Sub Station due to Poly Chlorinated Biphenyles (PCB) contamination and will be charged to each customer on a kWh basis and which will fluctuate from time to time.

Adjustments will be made periodically to account for over and under recovery of soil remediation at the Gaw Sub Station.
